

2. Stay informed: Know all you can about the topic you want to talk about, whether it's their favourite game or an online issue like pornography.

3. Start off right: Keep it age-appropriate and use the right language to help build digital resilience.

4. Tackle the tricky topics: Provide your child with accurate information before they try to learn for themselves.

5. Learn together: Use interactive online tools and news stories to learn about online safety together.


