Message from the Headteacher

Dear Parents and Carers,

A rainy start to a bank holiday weekend but lots to catch up on in this week's newsletter. We are very lucky to have such a committed community wanting to work together to make Churchfields even better for all of our children.

One of the points was helping families access **information about support for children with additional needs**. You can see our full offer here . Our SEND Information Report, which includes the pathways for children with additional needs and the resources available to support in school is here . We also have some resources you can use at home, which can be found here . Some of this information is not in the most user-friendly format, which is something for us to work on, but we thought it may be useful to signpost where it is.

If you have any questions about your child's learning or development, please speak to the class teacher in the first instance or you can speak with Mrs White who is our inclusion leader. We also had a really productive discussion at the PTA meeting last night about how we can make events as accessible as possible for all children. I thank you all for your input.

As you are aware, we don't currently have a **Iollipop person** for our crossing on Churchfields Road. The service is provided by the council, they are not employed by the school, and we are hoping they can recruit someone soon. The job advert is here (with an incorrect map and school name in the text, but it is us!) – please do pass this on if you know anyone who might be interested. In the meantime, I intend to put up some signs to ask drivers to be considerate in letting children cross at the busy times.

And finally, a big shout out to the staff who have made some great events for children happen last week! Year 4 had an excellent time on their overnight visit to **Frylands Wood**, thank you to all the parents/carers for transporting their own and helping other families to and from the trip to help keep it affordable for everyone. 




