International Research Group Visit Churchfields

We were proud to host a team of international education researchers at school this morning.

The group are working with the University of Queensland and are carrying out research across England, Singapore, Bangladesh and Australia to investigate how different kinds of evidence and information are used in schools around the world to improve children's learning.

They met with teachers and a group of children from Year 5 and Year 6 who answered questions about how they get feedback in school, what tests are for, how teachers might use information/data to help them teach as well as sharing favourite subjects and their experiences of school life.







Year 3 – 6 Parent/Carer Workshop How to help your child learn multiplication tables




The National Curriculum states that by the end of Year 4, pupils should know their times table facts up to 12×12 and have introduced a test called the 'Multiplication Tables Check' to be taken in June for all children in Year 4.


Having quick recall of times tables facts gives children a solid foundation in mathematics that will help them work out a variety of calculations easily and quickly. Knowing times tables facts provides the building blocks for understanding learning in Years 4, 5 and 6, such as long multiplication, long division, fractions and fraction of numbers, algebra and solving word problems.

To help parents/carers with strategies to support children learning their times tables in Years 3 - 6 we are pleased to offer a virtual 'workshop' on Tuesday 10th January at 1.30-2.30pm and again at 6-7pm. The content is the same in each session, the link will be emailed to you all next week.
