Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to the final half term of the 2022/23 academic year. I hope you all had a good holiday and we have had a busy week with launching new topics and books, trips out and the Early Years 2023 welcome meeting last night. Thank you to all of you who completed the short surveys sent out two weeks ago – this is a useful way of exploring themes that have come up from some parents as widely as possible. It was clear from the survey that there is sufficient demand for holiday childcare that we should continue to pursue this – this will not start in summer 2023 as we will be having significant works on the boundary fences and gates taking place over the holidays. The surveys also showed us that the prospect of mixing the classes caused more concern about possible downsides than the potential advantages, so we will not pursue this further. Thank you for your feedback on behaviour policy, homework and reading – all of the trends were shared with staff on INSET day and we are working on improving these parts of our provision for next academic year.
