Bronze will be awarded to a seed that has been planted properly and with some indication of growth.

We hope you have been enjoying growing your plants.

The judges will be visiting Churchfields on **Thursday 29th June**.

The children who are participating in this competition, please bring in your plant entries labelled with the child's full name, class name and plant name in the morning of 29th June and place them on the tables that will be put out in the KS1 playground.

The judges will award each participant with Gold, Silver or Bronze certificate for their efforts.

If your plant has flowered early, a photograph of the plant at its best, along with the plant can be submitted on 29th June.
