#### Year 3 – 6 Parent/Carer Workshop – Times Tables

The National Curriculum states that by the end of Year 4, pupils should know their times table facts up to  $12 \times 12$  and have introduced a test called the 'Multiplication Tables Check' to be taken in June for all children in Year 4.


Having quick recall of times tables facts gives children a solid foundation in mathematics that will help them work out a variety of calculations easily and quickly. Knowing times tables facts provides the building blocks for understanding learning in Years 4, 5 and 6, such as long multiplication, long division, fractions and fraction of numbers, algebra and solving word problems.

To help parents/carers with strategies to support children learning their times tables in Years 3 - 6 we are pleased to offer a virtual 'workshop' on Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> January at 1.30-2.30pm and again at 6-7pm. The content is the same in each session, the link will be emailed to you all nearer the time.
