## **Spring Term at Churchfields Primary School**

We have had a very enjoyable term at Churchfields and here are just a few highlights. In January, our choirs had an amazing opportunity to perform at the 02 Arena with over 8000 other children as part of Young Voices.









In English, our Year 5, 6 and Ash classes enjoyed 'A Midsummer Night's Dream' performed by The Young Shakespeare Company, and our younger children enjoyed a visit from The Hobgoblin Theatre Company who put on an exciting and immersive production of Little Red Riding Hood.

In Science, Year 4 have been studying electricity. They made static electricity with balloons which could then stick to things and move paper fish and used a Van de Graaff machine that made their hair go static when they touched the metal. In Reception, our children became palaeontologists for the day when they met some animatronic dinosaurs!









In sport, we were really pleased to welcome the boys' teams from Marian Vian for friendly matches on our large sports field and we will be hosting matches for our girls' teams next term.









We have also celebrated World Book Day and collected donations for the Turkey-Syria Earthquake Appeal. As you can see the children have been very busy! We do hope you will choose Churchfields Primary for your child, and we will be able to welcome them in September.
